

What is the PhDnet?

=> simply all the PhDs of all institutes!



What are the Working Groups? => PhDs interested in helping with:

- Secretary Group > The Glue that keeps the Network together.
- Webgroup > provides the infrastructure that everyone can connect with(in) the PhDnet.
- General Meeting Group > has the freedom of creating its own large scale event with important, but also less serious topics.
- Equal Opportunity Group > (more info on their page click the link)
- Offspring Group > the Magazine: Your PhD, Your Story, Publish your thoughts and inspirations with us. the Podcast: Your PhD, Your Life, Tell us your story and we get it heard.
- Survey Group > conducts a survey for doctoral researchers by doctoral researchers to assess the positives and negatives of pursuing research at the MPS and highlight aspects that need change.
- Open Science Group > aims to make research at the MPS more accessible, transparent and reproducible.

Unlike the Steering Group, the WGs accept members at any time of the year!

Go meet them in their room on gather.town!

The GM21 will end with the *election* of the <u>Steering Group</u>. This gives them a strong representation power, and legitimizes their discussions with the MPS administration.

Like the steering wheel of a boat, this group gives the right direction for the improvement of the life and work of all the PhD researchers.

But only because YOU voice out your opinion through the annual survey, they are then reliable representatives of your interests.

They also coordinate more specific projects via the Working Groups.

Any PhD researcher can be candidate,

but only External Representatives of the MPIs can vote.

There is 1 vote / institute. If the External Representative cannot join, they must tell it to the Secretary Group, and pass on their right via a proxy (info sent by email).

Candidates can announce themselves all along the GM21 to the current Steering or Secretary Group (go to their room in gather.town), or at the election call.

The positions to be filled are:

- Spokesperson
- Deputy spokesperson
- General secretary

- Chemistry-Physics-Technology section representative
- Biology-Medicine section representative
- Human Science section representative

gather.town tricks

- (A) Simulate your logging-in here and discover the most basic features:
 - O hit 'x' to interact with objects & contents
 - O press 'g' to walk through people
 - O 'private spaces' limit your discussion to the people in the room
 - O right-click the map to move quickly there
 - O rescale the map in Settings > Manual Canvas Zoom
- (B) Audio & video info here
 - O more privacy with Settings > Auto Idle
 - O reduce the background noise in Settings > SFX volume
 - O mute the whole event (background and people) using right-click on the browser's tab
- (C) Click on people's name in the left panel to:
 - O chat
 - O find them ('follow')
 - O display details about them (you can edit this on your own profile)
- + Try to keep your video on, if not your mic ...

Zoom usage

When you arrive in Zoom ...

- ... switch off camera and mic (use a nice pic instead :p).
- ... use your real name (to help us exclude intruders).

When you have a question/remark ...

- ... write it in the chat: we collect all comments and present them to the speaker at the end.
- ... raise your hand during the Q&A, and you will be allowed to speak up.
- ... interact freely with the speaker in gather.town (not always possible try a request).

Two slots are expected to break out the main Zoom room:

(a) Monday afternoon > Mental Health discussions

There are 6 private rooms in gather.town where individuals, or small groups can meet to discuss and share on some topics of their own choice. It is not a mandatory activity, only a possibility for all of you to relieve some of the stress, pressure, worries, questions, daily-life weight that everyone encounters in one form or another. They are accessible at any time, with some dedicated help being especially present on Monday afternoon.

(b) Tuesday morning > parallel sessions of PhD Science

After the main "Journey Talks" where former PhDs share their daily experience, we suggest an opening on the extended spectrum of science developed in the MPS. 12 PhD researchers will present their work in 10 minutes for non-specialized audience. These are split by topics in 3 Zoom breakout rooms (chemistry-physics-technology // human science // biology-medicine).

You are encouraged to go and see different topics to discover something new, which you won't witness in your MPI.
